

SCRAP ACCEPTANCE POLICY

To ensure that we maintain our efficiency and recycle in an environmentally responsible manner, we need your help when preparing scrap metal for our facility.

For environmental and safety reasons please ensure your scrap metal does NOT contain any of the following:

- 1. Combustible or explosive materials.
- 2. Paint or aerosol containers unless purges, punctured and free of foreign material.
- 3. Gasoline, diesel or other petroleum products or containers unless purged, punctured or free of foreign material.
- 4. Oil cans and un-punctured oil filters still on motor blocks.
- 5. Drums and paint cans of any size and type must be open, empty and cleaned.
- 6. 45 gallon drums must be empty, odor free and tops completely off.
- 7. Closed containers and cylinders including hydraulic containers.
- 8. Cans that contain paint, water sealer, pesticides or other toxic chemicals unless cleaned of toxic material.
- 9. Asbestos of any kind (such as pipe insulation and surface material).
- 10. Air conditioning and refrigeration units containing chlorofluorocarbons (CFC's & HCFC's) must provide proof of evacuation or freon removal charges will apply.
- 11. PCB containing material such as capacitors, ballasts and transformers.
- 12. Automotive air bags containing sodium azide.
- 13. Lead containing materials, unless approved in advance (eg. Lead acid batteries).
- 14. Fluorescent or mercury vapor lights and related fixtures.
- 15. Cathode ray tubes (CRT's) and liquid crystal displays (LCD's), or any commodity containing a CRT or LCD, such as computer monitors, laptop screens and televisions.
- 16. Radioactive materials and containers.
- 17. Any material containing hazardous, special, or toxic substances, materials or wastes.
- 18. Munitions scrap of any kind unless inspected and approved in advance.
- 19. Rail road scrap unless accompanies by appropriate ownership documents.
- 20. Ammunition and any kind of explosive materials.
- 21. Waste containing mercury.
- 22. Chain link, barbwire or chicken fence.
- 23. Steel cable or wire rope.
- 24. Any steel thicker than 3 inches.
- 25. Old refrigeration units containing ammonia.
- 26. Residential, commercial or industrial appliances contain PCB's.
- 27. Break Shoes.
- 28. No gas or propane tanks (no exceptions).
- 29. Tires (no exceptions).
